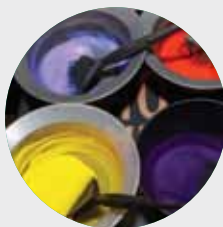

We offer world recognised VTCT Qualifications for our Diploma and Certificate Courses. VTCT is a specialist awarding organisation offering vocational and technical qualifications in a range of service sectors. Awarding since 1962 VTCT is a charitable organisation involved in many of the new initiatives being introduced into the education system, including the embedding of general education skills and online-assessment. VTCT now has more than 800 approved centres worldwide.

Our Salon Apprentices Programme offers apprentices the option to sit their Trade Exams and gain Official papers upon completion of their Apprenticeships. These papers are needed for travelling and training and otherwise unavailable to apprentices in the South East. Learners continue their Apprenticeship while attending Academy 1 day per week for skills and technical training, thus enabling faster progress and official papers of qualification from the Dept. of Education and Skills.

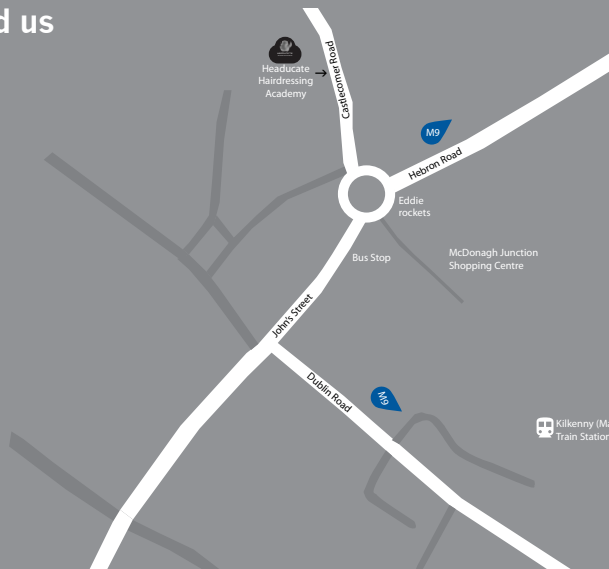


Places are limited to ensure a high standard of training.
